Sri: Sri:niva:sa Kalya:Nam (Brief procedure)



'Yedurukolu utsavam' (Meeting of Bride and Bridegroom before marriage to bless all the devotees)

The devotees will be divided into two parts as per their interest (suggestion: parents with girls can take groom side and with boys on bride side, others as they wish) and will follow the procession of Lord Sri:niva:sa in one palanquin chanting 'Purusha su:ktam' and those who follow the other palanquin with Goddess Sri:de:vi& Bhu:de:vi chanting 'Sri:su:ktam&Bhu:su:ktam' along with 'mangaLa va:idyam' and 'maNgala ha:ratulu' and all assemble at a place. The priests and devotees praise the great qualities of Lord Sri:niva:sa and Goddess Sri:de:vi & Bhu:de:vi and glorify the matching of divine couple and take the agreement of all the devotees to perform the divine marriage. The devotees will exchange the 'mangala dravya' from both the sides by offering turmeric, kumkum and scented water and the procession will come back to the 'kalyaNa mandapam'.

The Vedic procedure of Kalyanam will be performed by the learned priests in the presence of devotees. This includes, Sri Vishwaksena A:radhana, PuNya:ha va:chanam, Raksha: su:tra dha:raNam, Yagno:pavi:ta dha:raNam, Pravara pathanam, Madhu parka nivedanam, MaNgala:staka pathanam, Kanya: da:na Maha:sankalpa pathanam, Gudaji:ra prada:nam, Ma:ngaLya dha:raNam, Akshata:ro:paNam and MaNgala:ra:ti.
